ELIGIBLE ENTRANTS:

1. ASID Hawaii Chapter individual members in good standing may enter as the lead or additional designer(s).
2. Students (ASID Student members and Non-members) who are enrolled at an accredited Interior Design Program in the State of Hawaii.

ELIGIBLE ENTRIES & REQUIREMENTS:

Failure to comply with these specifications will result in disqualification of entry and forfeiture of the entry fees.

1. Submitting entrants must be located within the geographic boundary (all Hawaiian Islands) of the ASID Hawaii Chapter. It is the responsibility of each entrant to give credit to all designers/firms and photographers in the project.
2. Up to three (3) separate projects can be entered per designer/firm; the designer(s) on the project must meet one of the above eligible entrant criteria to qualify.
3. Each singular project may only be entered in one category; submitting a project in more than one category may result in disqualification.
4. A project that has been previously entered into an ASID Hawaii Design Excellence Awards competition MAY be re-entered as long as it did NOT previously win an ASID Hawaii Design Excellence Award, including Award of Excellence, Award of Honor, Award of Merit, or Honorable Mentioned.
5. Age of Project: A project cannot be entered if it was completed before 2021.
6. Images: Ensure that all images are free of any watermarks, titles or descriptions that identify the designer(s) or client(s). An exception to this rule would be projects that include a corporate brand or company name/logo as part of the design but does not identify/ feature individuals. Project images that do not maintain anonymity will be disqualified.
7. Entrants agree to follow publicity guidelines as established by ASID Hawaii and authorize ASID Hawaii to use any and all materials submitted for marketing and publicity purposes in perpetuity.
8. Unfinished Projects: Professionals must submit completed work. Only students can submit conceptual designs.

JUDGING:

A panel of independent, distinguished design professionals will review the entries anonymously and select category winners based on a 100-point score system. Each criteria will be worth 10 points. All entries will be judged by the highest standards of our profession, and comparatively with other entries in that category. ASID Hawaii reserves the right to not award a category if the projects submitted do not meet the standards of the independent judging panel. If the judges observe a code violation on an entry, the entry may be rejected and not awarded. ASID Hawaii reserves the right not to award a winner in any category.

AWARDS & RECOGNITION:

Winners will be announced at the 2024 ASID Hawaii Design Excellence Awards Gala on October 12, 2024. The Award of Excellence winner(s) will receive a physical, custom award. The Award of Honor, Merit, and Honorable Mention winner(s) will receive a certificate of accomplishment. The ASID Hawaii Chapter will publish all winners and honorees in the ASID Hawaii E-Newsletter, social media, and ASID website. Further winner recognition/publication details will be announced at a later date.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

The following information is required to submit your application:

1. **Certification & Waiver Form**
2. **Client Release Form**
3. **Project Identification Form**
4. **Project Description Form:** Up to 750 words max.
5. **Floor Plans:** Submitted in PDF format only
6. **Project Photos** (for judging panel): Up to 10 total photos (JPEG or PNG image).
7. **Feature Photo:** This photo (JPEG or PNG image) is considered the primary image from the project.
8. **Media Photos:** Any additional project photos (JPEG or PNG image) you would like to see published if you win and will be used in the awards slide presentation.
9. **Headshots:** Provide individual or group headshots of the project team (JPEG or PNG image). An official company logo is acceptable in lieu of individual or team photos.
10. **Narrative:** To be used in post-awards publishing and promotion. Up to 100 words max.

- \$150 Per Additional Entries
- \$30 Student First Entry
- \$15 Per Student Additional Entries

DEADLINES:

- Deadline to submit Letter of Intent: May 31, 2024 5:00pm HST
- Deadline for project submissions: June 30, 2024 5:00pm HST

WAIVER:

By submitting your project, files, and photos, you are acknowledging your understanding that if your project is chosen as a winner, the ASID Hawaii Chapter may use in whole, or part, your project submittal in their publicity for awards recognition and future promotional material for the 2024 ASID Hawaii Design Excellence Awards.

AWARD CATEGORIES

RESIDENTIAL:

R01 – SINGLE SPACE: A space contained within a residence, i.e. Living Room, Bedroom, Study, Dining Room, Kitchen, Bathroom, etc.

R02 – SMALL RESIDENCE: Whole-house project that is under 1,500 square feet

R03 – MID-SIZE RESIDENCE: Whole-house project that is between 1,500 to 3,500 square feet.

R04 – LARGE RESIDENCE: Whole-house project that is over 3,500 square feet.

R05 – MODEL HOME/CONDO: Condos, townhouses, apartments.

R06 – UNIVERSAL DESIGN: Projects having shown use of the examples of Universal remodeling/building or Aging In Place within a residence.

COMMERCIAL:

C01 – HEALTHCARE FACILITIES: Hospitals, clinics, specialty healthcare, etc.

C02 – HOSPITALITY: Hotels, resorts, country clubs, spas, etc.

C03 – INSTITUTION/EDUCATION: Museums, libraries, schools, daycare centers, churches, etc.

C04 – OFFICES

C05 – RESTAURANT/BARS

C06 – RETAIL: Stores, showrooms, malls, etc.

BEST VALUE: Demonstrates best use of resources within a limited budget.

BV01 – RESIDENTIAL

BV02 – COMMERCIAL

CUSTOM DESIGNED OBJECT/DETAIL: An original design/detail relating to a single object, product, or installation. Must include process documentation (sketch/drawing/digital model, photographs, etc.)

CD01 – Furnishings/Casegoods/Millwork

CD02 – Installations

SUSTAINABILITY: The design of a space depicting the highest ideals in sustainable design. Must have qualified for LEED or WELL Certification rating (all levels).

SU01 – RESIDENTIAL

SU02 – COMMERCIAL

STUDENT: Open to students of an accredited Interior Design Program. Projects completed as part of an Interior Design Curriculum. Student Alumni may submit a student project as long as they graduated between Fall 2022 - Fall 2023.

ST01 – RESIDENTIAL

ST02 – COMMERCIAL

GRAND OVERALL: Will be selected from the entry submissions by the judges.

CHAPTER AWARDS:

Chapter Award Call for Nomination information will be sent separately. The Design Awards Committee will judge the entries anonymously.

1. ASID Lifetime Achievement Award
 - Recognizes an individual ASID member for their special contributions to the interior design industry in the State of Hawaii.
2. Industry Partner Award
 - Recognizes an individual Industry Partner who have made special contributions to the interior design industry in the State of Hawaii.
3. Emerging Professional Award
 - Open to interior/junior designers practicing in the State of Hawaii with less than 10 years of professional practice.
